Mail this completed form to your local election authority. Addresses can be found on the Missouri Secretary of State’s website, sos.mo.gov. Missouri law requires that requests for absentee ballots must be received by 5:00 p.m. on the second Wednesday prior to Election Day if the ballot is to be mailed. The deadline for absentee voting in person in the office of the election authority is 5:00 p.m. on the day prior to the election. If you registered by mail and this is your first time voting, you must provide a copy of either: (1) an ID issued by the Federal government, state of Missouri, or a local election authority; (2) an ID issued by a Missouri institution (public or private) of higher education; (3) a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check or other government document that contains your name and address; or (4) a driver’s license or state ID card issued by another state.
