Legal Reasons for Voting by Absentee Ballot

- 1. Absence on election day
- 2. Incapacity or confinement due to illness or physical disability, including caring for a person who is incapacitated or confined due to illness or disability and resides at the same address
- 3. Religious belief or practice
- 4. Employment as an election authority or by the election authority (for example, as an election judge) at a location other than your polling place, as a first responder, health care worker, or member of law enforcement
- 5. Incarceration, provided all qualifications for voting are retained
- 6. Certified participation in the address confidentiality program ("Safe at Home") established under 589.660 to 589.681, RSMo, because of safety concerns

No reason needed 2 weeks before each election.

No notarization of the voter signature is required for reason 2 or 5.
